掲載しているサンプル問題は、総合型選抜（9月募集／11月募集）【基礎学力評価型】の「基礎力テスト（英語）」のサンプル問題です。「基礎力テスト」では1教科当たり試験時間30分（2教科の場合は60分、3教科の場合は90分）、大問2題の出題を予定しております。

【作成の趣旨及び留意点】

このサンプル問題は、「基礎力テスト（英語）」について、具体的なイメージを持っていただき、受験に向けて準備ができるように作成・公表しております。

あくまでもサンプル問題として公表しており、試験の際に全く同様の形式での問題が出題されるものではありません。

1 次の英文を読み、各設問に答えなさい。解答は、それぞれ①～④の中からもっとも適切なものを1つ選びなさい。(解答番号 ～)

What is the greatest of all the regularly held sporting events in the world? Many Americans would answer "the Super Bowl of American football." While this is certainly the sporting event on TV by the largest number of Americans every year, the sport is not ⁽²⁾appreciated very much outside the United States. Likewise, the major events of baseball – the American World Series and the World Baseball Classic – are completely ignored in many parts of the world. However, there are two sporting events that never fail to fascinate millions of people on every continent: the World Cup of soccer and the Olympic Games.

The first World Cup was organized in 1930, and the worldwide soccer tournament has been held every four years since then, except for the 1940s, when World War II made ⁽³⁾it impossible. The early World Cups mainly featured teams from South America and Europe, and to this day all World Cup champions have come from these two regions. However, soccer's popularity has grown wildly in Asia and Africa in recent decades, and interest in the World Cup has spread along with it.

The Olympic Games, of course, have a longer history, especially if we include the ancient Olympics held in Greece over 2,500 years ago. The modern Olympic Games started in 1896. They have been held every four years except for one cancellation because of World War I and, like the World Cup, two cancellations World War II. From 1924, separate Winter Olympic Games were held some months before the "Summer Games" in the same year, and sometimes in the same country. (In 1994, the Winter Games began to be held two years following the Summer Games, so that the Winter Olympic Games and the soccer World Cup have since shared the same year.) From their start, the modern Olympic Games attracted interest from people in the countries that sent athletes to the games. As the number of ⁽⁶⁾such countries has increased, so has the popularity of the Olympics.
